The dunes sagebrush lizard has been proposed for listing since the last CNOR was published in November 2010.

The Sonoran desert tortoise was designated a candidate species following publication of the November 2010 CNOR, but will receive a proposed listing rule or "not warranted" determination in WildEarth Guardians' settlement agreement.

The striped newt, Berry Cave salamander, and gopher tortoise were designated candidate species following publication of the November 2010 CNOR and will not receive either a proposed listing rule or "not warranted" determination under either settlement agreement.
