



**ORDER APPROVING PLAINTIFF'S AND FEDERAL DEFENDANT'S
JOINT MOTION TO APPROVE SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT**

THIS MATTER came before the Court on Plaintiff's and Federal Defendant's April 15, 2011 "Joint Motion to Approve Settlement Agreement," Dkt. No. 95. The Court, being otherwise fully advised of the premises, hereby finds that the Joint Motion is well taken and GRANTS the Joint Motion. Pursuant Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 60(b), the Court approves the Settlement Agreement between Plaintiff and Federal Defendant attached as Exhibit A to the Joint Motion. In accordance with the Settlement Agreement, ¶ 1, the Court hereby dismisses all counts of Plaintiff's Complaint with prejudice, and retains jurisdiction to oversee compliance with the terms of the Settlement Agreement and to resolve any motions to modify such terms, until Federal Defendant satisfies its obligations under the Settlement Agreement.
